



Boarding Information

Boarding for dogs, cats and select exotic pets

Here at Abadie Veterinary Hospital we are happy to board dogs, cats, and some select exotics such as rabbits, ferrets, hamsters, guinea pigs, and some birds (must be arranged in detail).

Food will be provided, but feel free to bring your own labeled food for your pet's comfort. We encourage you to bring your own food if your pet has a sensitive stomach to a sudden change in diet which may cause soft stool or diarrhea.

*All exotic pets must be dropped off with their own food supply, water/food dishes if specific to that species or bedding material. Depending on the species, their own specialized cage may also need to be provided.

To help prevent virus transmission, we require boarding pets to be fully vaccinated. Pets must be current on required vaccinations given by a licensed veterinarian and have had a negative intestinal parasite exam within the last year. If this was provided at another veterinary clinic, copies of medical records must be provided either in advance of boarding or at the time of drop off. Or the pet will be vaccinated here. An estimate of charges can be given at the time boarding is scheduled. All dogs and cats are given a capstar at time of drop off that will rid them of any preexisting fleas they may have.

*Vaccinations required for dogs: Rabies, Distemper, Adenovirus, Parainfluenza, Hepatitis, Leptospirosis, Coronavirus, Parvovirus and Bordetella (Kennel Cough).

*Vaccinations required for cats: Rabies, Feline Viral Rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus, Panleukopenia (FVRCP), and Bordetella (Kennel Cough). Please let us know if you know the pet is POSITIVE FIV or HIV at time of boarding.

*Vaccinations required for ferrets: Rabies and Ferret distemper within the past year

Dogs are leash walked outside at least two to three times daily. We do not allow play time or other animal interaction with any other pet unless they are from the same family.

We are not responsible for any lost or damaged items (toys, blankets, or leashes) dropped off with pet. We provide blankets or towels for animals boarding with us. However, let us know if your pet might chew up the blanket as this might be a health hazard. We ask of you to take home with you any leashes or harnesses (if not required to walk on at all times) at time of drop off.
